ALL YEAR FRESHMAN SEMINAR COURSE

All freshmen will take the Freshman Seminar course. Along with career exploration and development, this one-year course teaches essential success skills such as how to take initiative and responsibility, effective teamwork and communication, critical thinking and problem-solving.
